




### Q2 Which days did you attend?





### Q3 Overall, how would you rate the CRISM Prairies meeting?





## Q4 How helpful was the content presented at the CRISM Prairies meeting?





# Q5 How was the meeting at updating members on Node activities (Cam Wild, Colleen Dell, David Hodgins)?





# Q14 How would you rate the meeting's attention to advancing reconciliation and relationship building?





# Q15 How well did the meeting provide a forum for members to give input into existing and future CRISM Prairies projects?





## Q16 How well did the CRISM Prairies meeting provide opportunities to build collaborative relationships? Was it...?









### Q19 What do you think about the length of the CRISM Prairies meeting?





### Q20 How comfortable did you feel asking questions at the event?





### Q21 How comfortable did you feel voicing your opinions?







## Q23 How would you rate the quality of the facilities where the CRISM Prairies meeting was held?









# Q27 How valuable were the networking opportunities at the CRISM Prairies meeting?





# Q28 To what extent did attending this meeting broaden your network of contacts and potential collaborators?




