Optimizing patient centered-care

 A 6-month, open-label, multi-site pragmatic randomized trial involving over 200 clients recruited from all 4 CRISM Nodes





- Address key barriers including patient preference for tapering over long-term maintenance therapy
- Establish external validity of buprenorphine/naloxone vs. methadone in the care of prescription opioid users



MORE PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

- Producing opioid use disorder guidelines for national dissemination and implementation
- Adapting contingency management interventions to the Canadian treatment context
- Developing online screening, selfmanagement, and referral to treatment resource for youth
