SUPPORT SERVICES

Intake and Referral

1st point of service for advocacy, supportive counselling, intake, assessment and referral in order to provide direction to appropriate services.

Adult Support Workers

Provide supported referrals and advocacy to increase access to community supports. Services offered on a continual basis addressing daily needs as well as long term goals, with the end point of services being determined by the client.

Four Directions Banking Services

A low barrier banking institution, providing financial literacy support and advice.

ID Storage

Provides safe storage, complex system navigation and advocacy in accessing identification.

Secure delivery system for mail and prescriptions offered through reception.

WATERWINGS

An employment readiness program that supports resume building, safety ticket accreditation, trade literacy, job searches and access to work gear.

YOUTH SERVICES

Youth Unit Drop-In

Provides relationship-based support and advocacy in finding housing, a source of income and assisting with the transition into to adulthood.

High-Risk Youth

Assist youth referred by Children and Family Services. Provides services that focus on self-care and harm reduction.

HOUSING

Housing First assists chronically homeless individuals as well as families, regardless of substance use and/or mental health issues.

CULTURAL SUPPORT

Indian Residential Schools Resolution Health Support Program

Offering weekly cultural events and programming

Available for individual spiritual guidance & ceremony. Access to elder providing support and guidance to the community.



DROP-IN

The heart of the centre and a place for the community to connect to services and with each other.

Lunch provided daily. Various activities, and community services hosted on a weekly basis.

Hours extended during winter months with the Winter Warming Program.

FAMILY SERVICES

Family Outreach and Visitations

Supporting families and their children with life skills, parenting skills and early childhood development.

Health for Two

City-wide partnership of 35 agencies, provides support for pregnant women and new parents.

STREETWORKS

Streetworks*

Harm Reduction supplies, education and advocacy and **NALOXONE training**. Nursing services available for the community on a walk-in basis.

MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES

On-site Addiction and Mental Health Services

Counselling, education, referrals, advocacy and assessments.

Mobile Outreach Addictions Team (MOAT)

Provides direct access to detox and substance use treatment support.

BSCS PROGRAMS ACROSS EDMONTON

Residential Services

Group homes, **Northstar Apartments** - 62 unit apartment building with BSCS manager.

Crisis Diversion Team

(In partnership with Hope Mission, 211 and REACH)
24/7 mobile distress response for Edmonton.

Ubuntu

(Collaborative Service Delivery)
Offers wraparound supports to families in northeast Edmonton together with Child and Family Services.

Youth Community Support Program

Offers supports for 20 youth with mental health/addiction diagnoses (residential/non-residential services).

Downtown Proud

(*Social Enterprise*)
Offers clean-up services to Edmonton, fostering successful employment and community re-integration.

Youth Employment Services

(*Social Enterprise*)
A moving, junk removal and residential cleaning company.

Citywide Street Outreach

On-foot outreach connecting those sleeping 'rough' with limited access to community services.

Winter Emergency Response Bus

Offers rides to shelters, basic needs, referrals to community services and a space to warm up and connect with staff. Runs November to May.
