NALOXONE TRAINING & DISTRIBUTION

SHELTER ACCOMMODATIONS

- DAYTIME
- OVERNIGHT
- TRANSITIONAL SERVICES for people awaiting housing, long-term addictions treatment, placement at alternative supportive facilities.

NURSING SERVICES - MINOR TREATMENT & EMERGENCY CARE

THE PLACE OF DIGNITY (POD)

Provides a strong harm reduction-based 24/7 supportive living service for high-acuity, low mobility inner city residents. Includes a managed alcohol component.

DETOXIFICATION SERVICES

- Complete comprehensive assessment
- Provide harm reduction information
- Manage medications as required
- Develop service plans
- Provide kitchen services, laundry and showers.



HARM REDUCTION EDUCATION

Offer workshops on a variety of topics, including: Permanent supportive housing; Housing First Program; Needle Distribution Program; Managed Alcohol; Safety Planning; CAT Peer Group; Concurrent Disorders Counselling.

MEDICALLY SUPERVISED INJECTION SERVICES

NEEDLE DISTRIBUTION PROGRAM

ON-SITE ADDICTION & MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES

An on-site addictions counsellor offers counselling, education, referrals and advocacy, while a visiting AHS mental health therapist offers increased access to similar AHS-specific programming.

WARM REFERRALS TO MEDICAL & SOCIAL SERVICES

GEORGE SPADY SOCIETY OFF-SITE PROGRAMMING & SERVICES

GEORGE'S HOUSE (4 BED)

Provides interim housing for men and women who are transitioning from detox to addictions treatment or housing and having to wait 4-6 weeks for a bed or home.

CHRISTOPHER'S PLACE (26 RESIDENT BUILDING)

Provides a safe, controlled environment for men and women who require significant permanent supports to maintain their independence in the community.

HOUSING FIRST TEAM

Provides Housing First program support to 80 people, to help them obtain permanent housing in the Edmonton area and provide them with ongoing support to maintain their housing.

MOBILE OUTREACH ADDICTIONS TEAM (MOAT)

Provides direct access to detox and substance use, i.e. treatment support. A partnership between George Spady Society and Boyle Street Community Services.

SPADY CLINICAL ACCESS TEAM (CAT)

Provides intensive clinical support for up to 210 people per year to access appropriate physical health, mental health, treatment related to substance use and other wellness supports.
