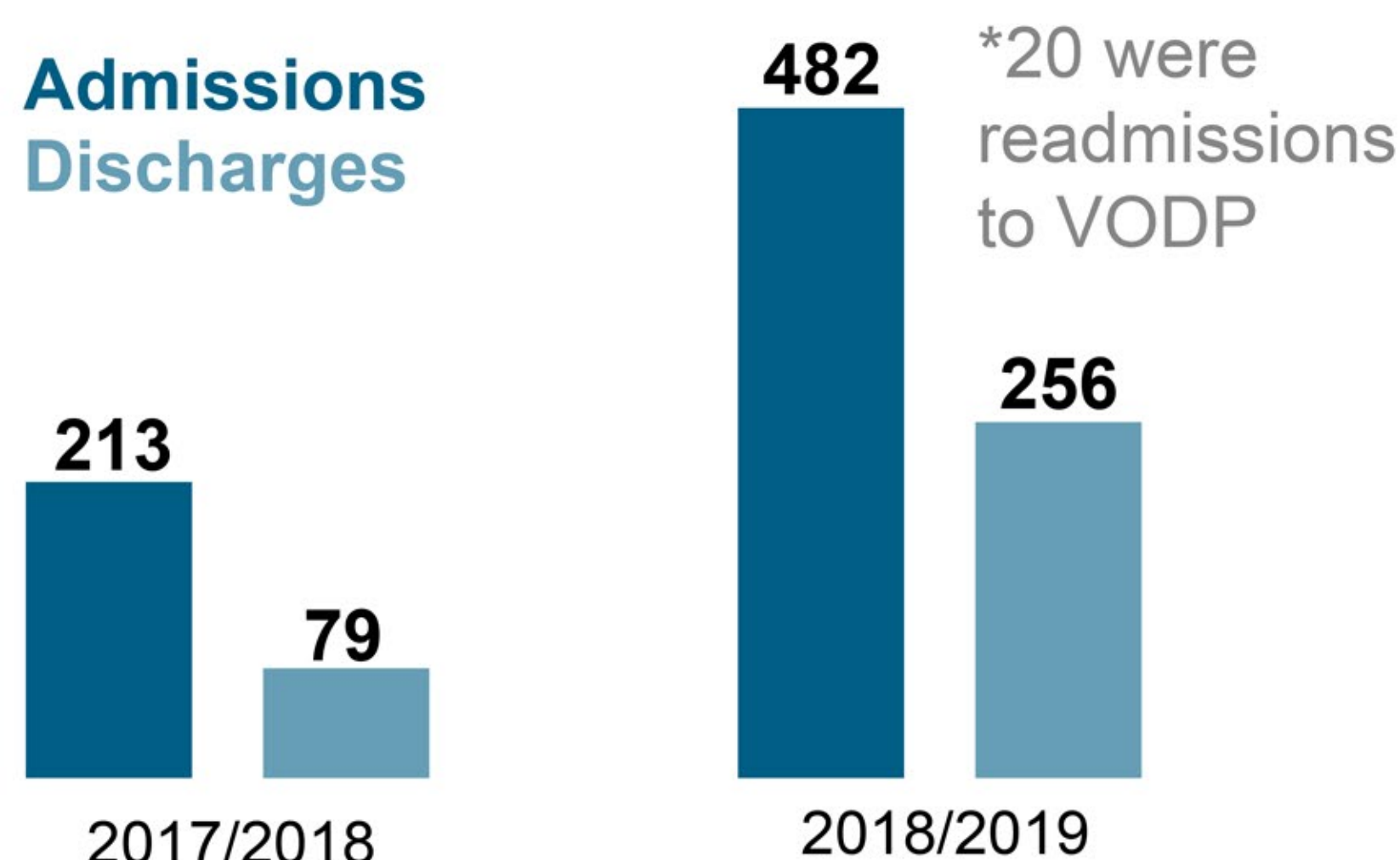
About the program

- The program runs 7 days a week from 8am to 8pm.



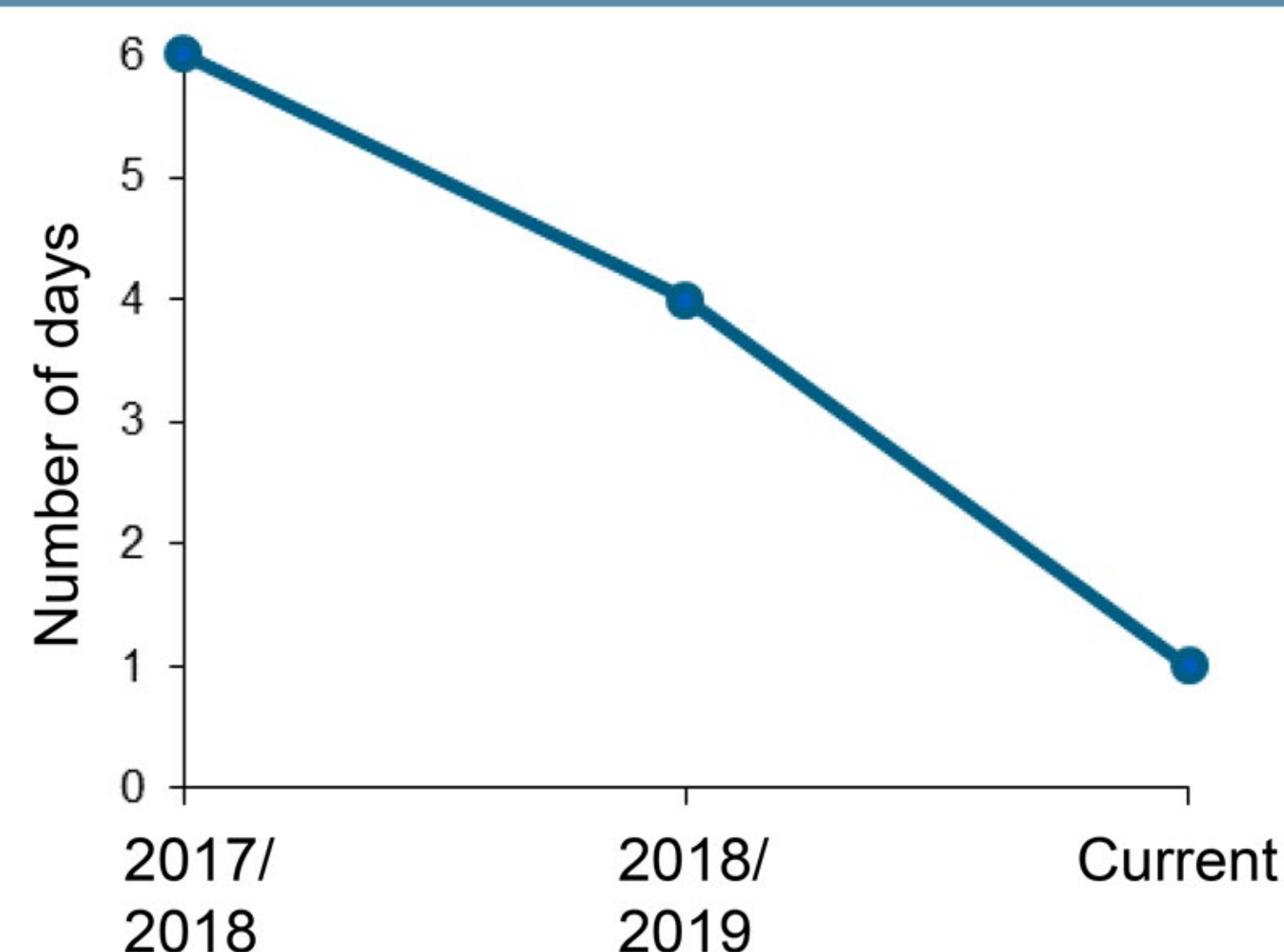

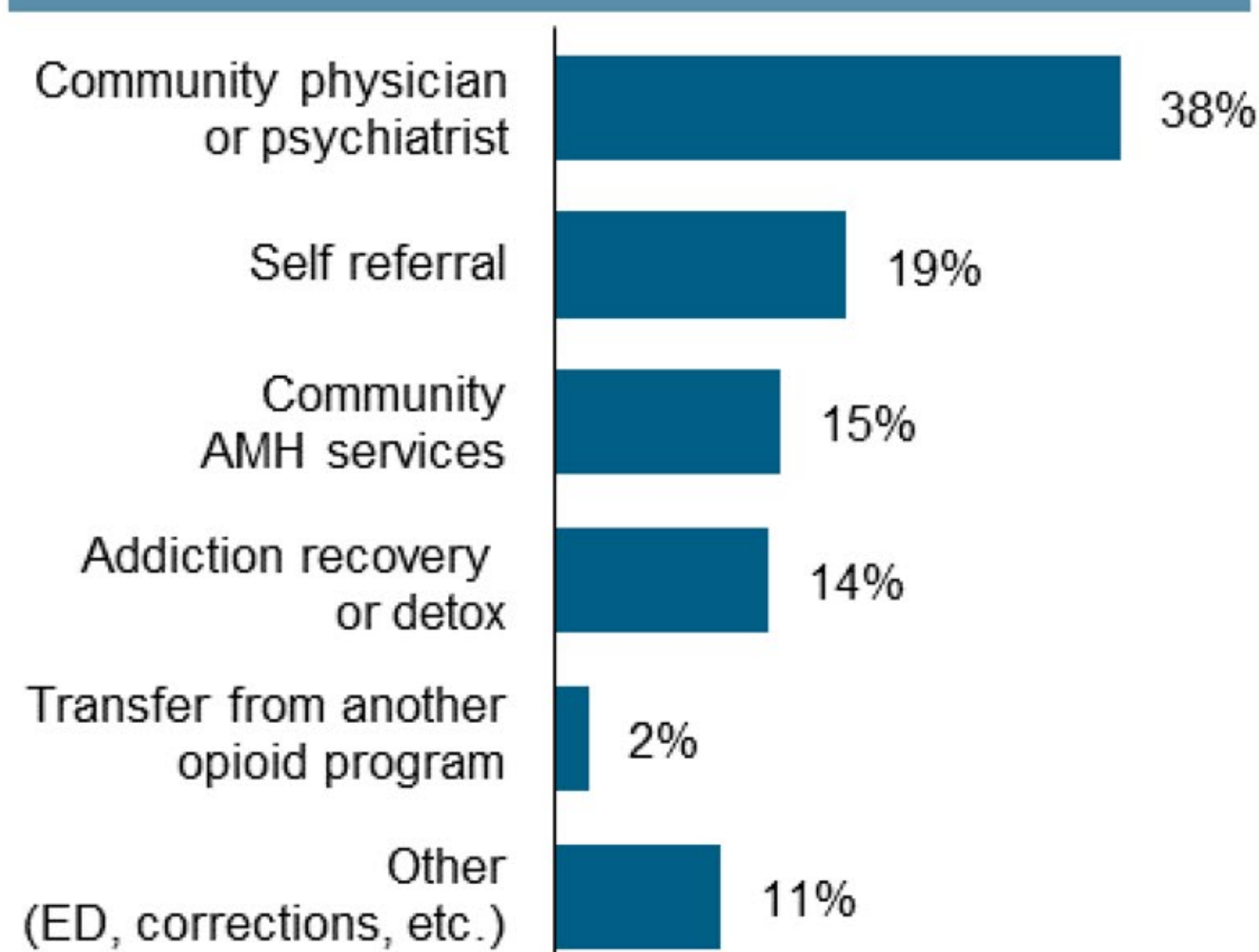
Wait times



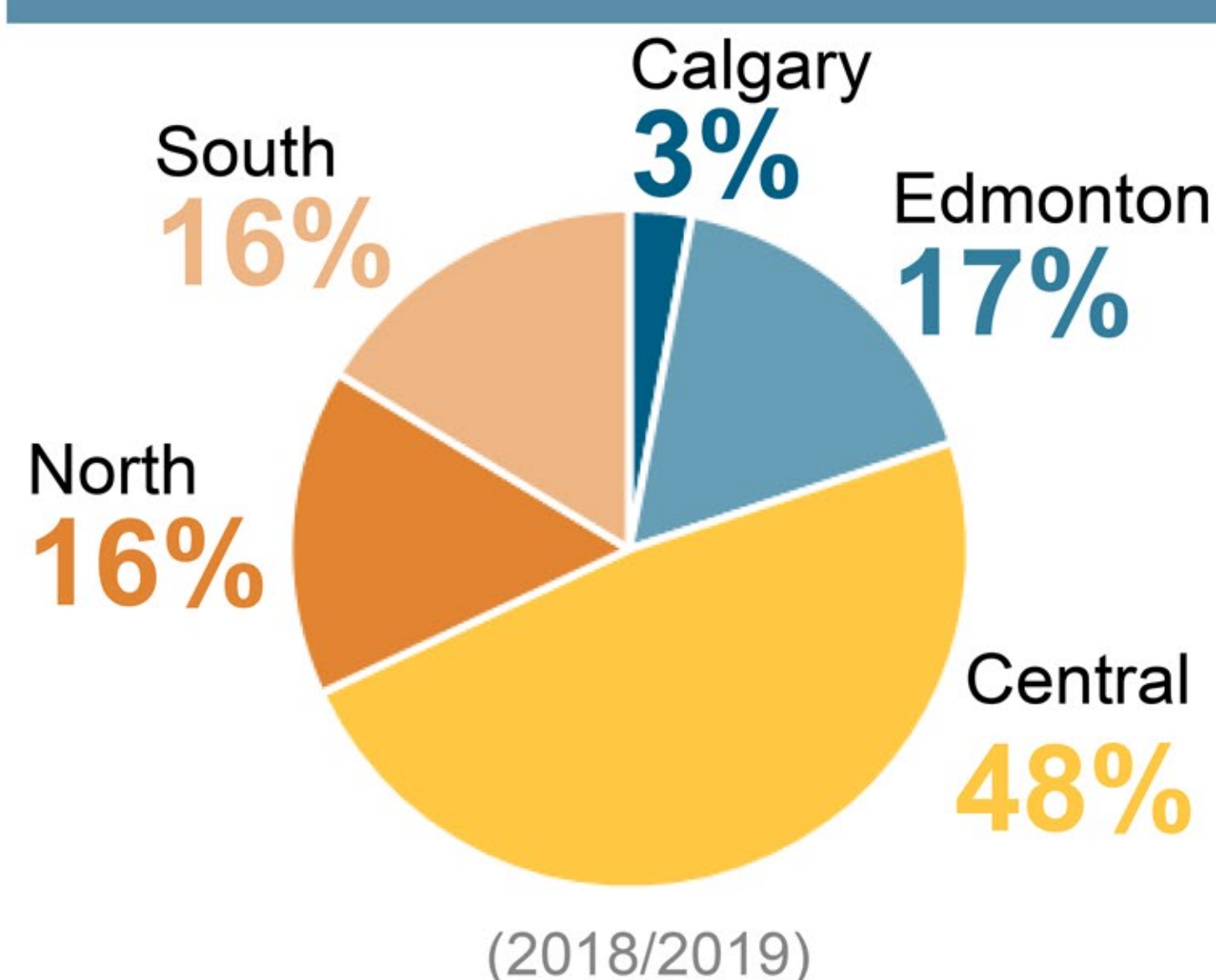
Median wait time: **Decreasing**

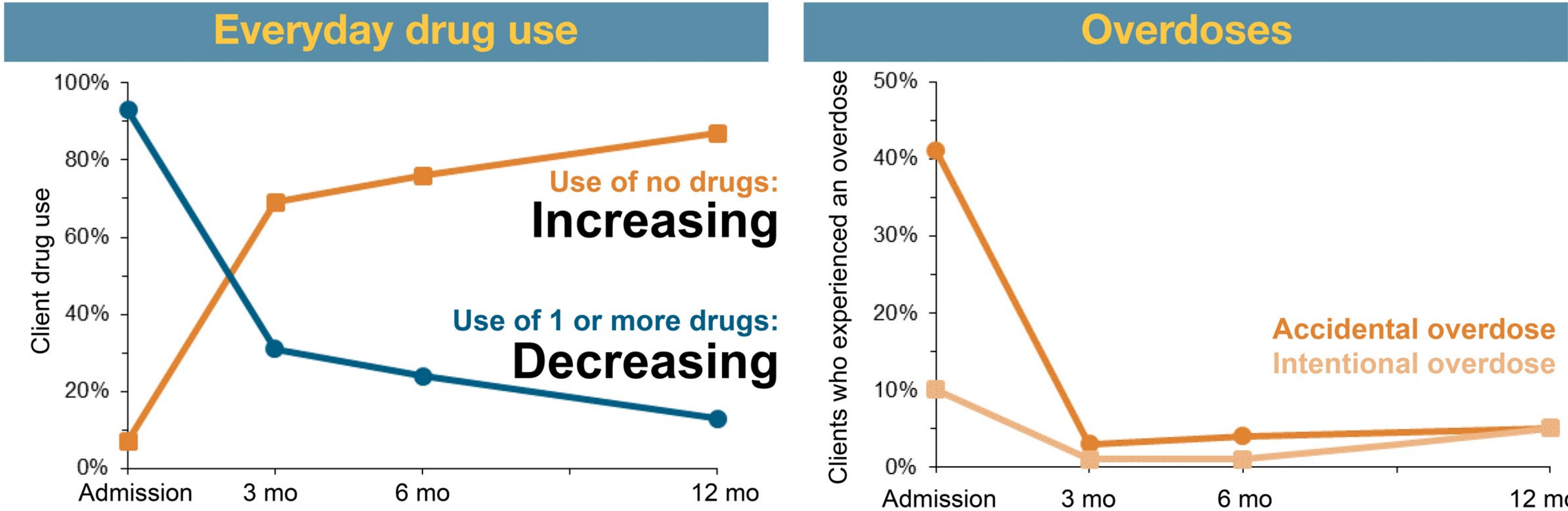

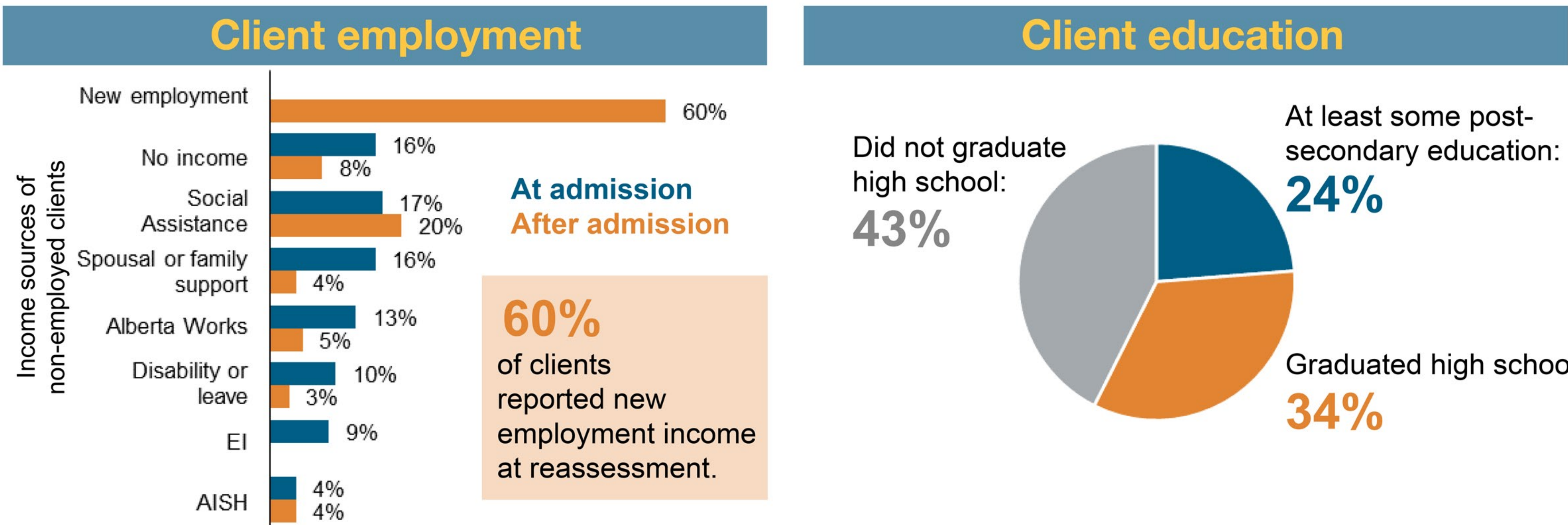
